

BY-LAWS

OF

TOWNSVILLE RESTORED MOTOR CYCLE CLUB INC.

The following By-Laws have been made by the Management Committee of the Townsville Restored Motor Cycle Club Inc. in accordance with the provisions of Clause 25, of the Rules of the Association. Any By-Law may be set aside by a General Meeting of Members.

BY-LAW 1

For the purposes of the Association the following classifications of motor cycle shall apply:-

1. A motor cycle – shall mean any two or three wheel, self-propelled, road vehicle which shall be divided into classes as follows:-

(a) A Veteran Motor Cycle - Is a motor cycle constructed before 31 December 1918.

(b) A Vintage Motor Cycle - Is a motor cycle constructed between 1 January 1919 and 31 December 1930.

(c) A Post Vintage Motor Cycle - Is a motor cycle constructed between 1 January 1931 and December 31 December 1945.

(d) A Post War Motor Cycle - Is a motor cycle constructed between 1 January 1946 and 31 December 1966.

(e) A Classic Motor Cycle - Is a motor cycle constructed between 1 January 1967 and 30 years prior to the present date, in line with SIV registration requirements.

2. All dates appearing in Clause 1 shall be inclusive.

BY-LAW 2

Applications for Membership:-

Applications for Membership of the Association will be accepted from any person having an interest in the Objects of the Association. An applicant need not own a motor cycle to apply for membership.

A potential member is required to attend three club events prior to applying for membership, one of which must be a meeting, the other events could be any club event on the calendar excluding Restorers Roundabouts.

BY-LAW 3

Sale of Motor Cycles:-

In accordance with Object (d) of the Rules of the Association, members are obliged to advise the Association of their intention to sell a SIV eligible motor cycle before placing it on the open market for sale.

BY-LAW 4

Club Events:-

Participation in official Association runs and any function held during the run is restricted to Association Members and their families. Members of similar clubs may attend by invitation and with the approval of the Management Committee. A visitor may attend a club event with the approval of the President or Vice President, with the express exclusion of the Restorers Roundabouts.

BY-LAW 5

Termination of Membership for Non-Payment of Dues:-

If a member has failed to become financial before the THIRD General Meeting following the Annual General Meeting, and signals their intention to remain in the Association, then as well as the outstanding fees already owed, that person is liable for a late payment fee, the value of which may vary from time to time as decided by the Management Committee.

BY-LAW 6

Eligibility of Management Committee Members for Awards

Management Committee members are eligible for awards such as the Restorer of the Year, provided that if nominated for such awards, they would be excluded from the final judging process for that award. If any Management Committee members or other members wish not to participate in such awards, they should notify the Secretary in writing on or before the July General Meeting for that year
